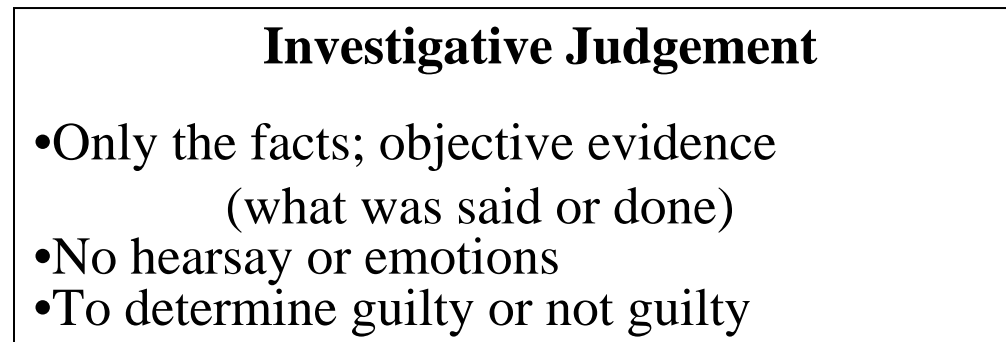


Three Phases of Judgment in America

- Review the facts
- Focus on damage done
- Hear from the persons affected
- Can be very emotional

- Immediately Released

*Person doesn't
have to be present*

Executive Judgment

- Review the facts
- Guilty person can make a statement
- People directly affected may observe
- Sentence is executed

*Person must be
present*

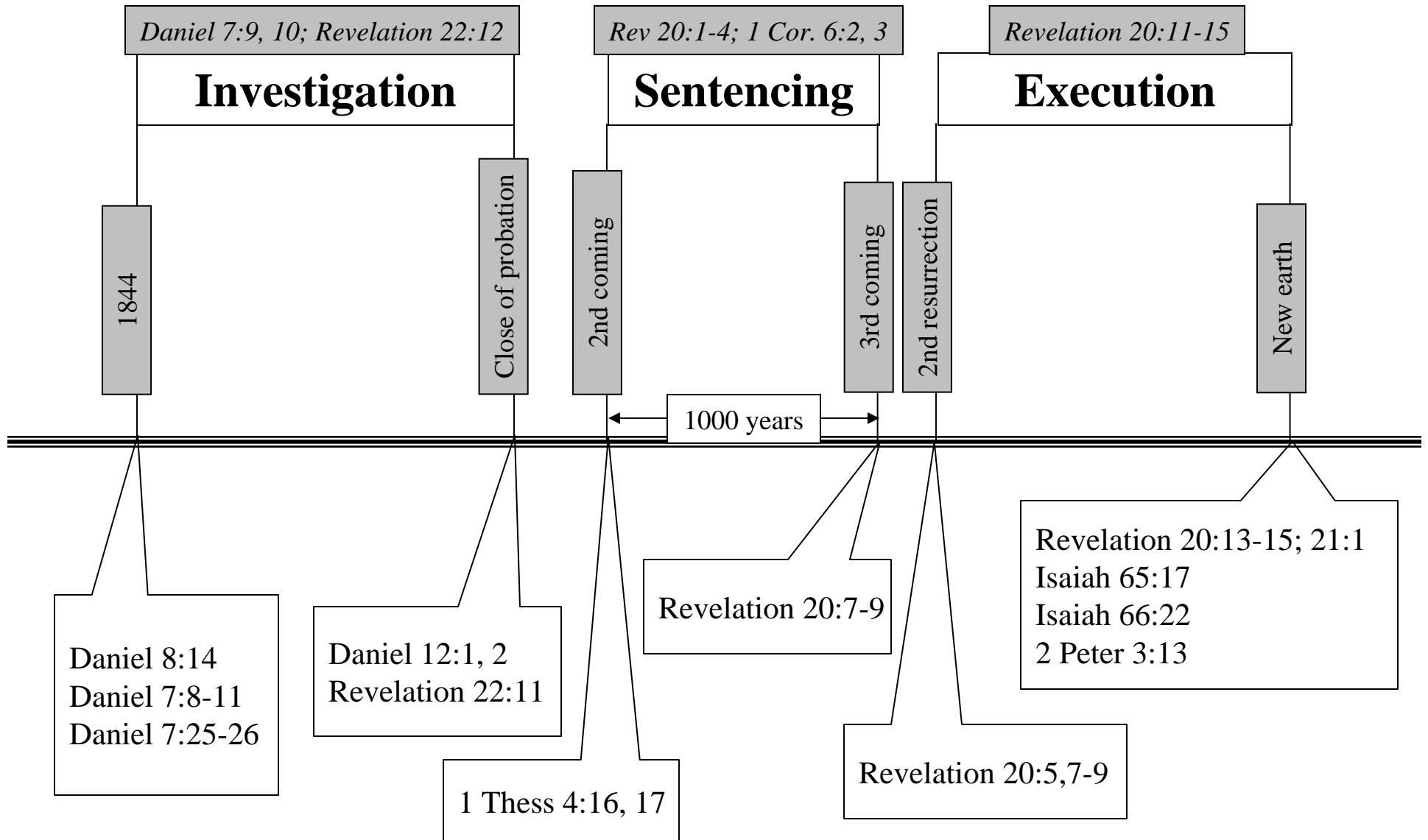
